



Hirschman Trail

Only a mile from the heart of downtown Nevada City, here is a great new trail system that gets you quickly out into nature with lots of different things to enjoy. The centerpiece is lovely Hirschman's Pond, named after the Hirschman brothers who were pioneer miners and merchants of the area. Besides the pond, the system utilizes some natural features in the terrain, such as a spur trail along Woods Ravine. The trail system was newly built to modern trail standards in 2010, with the eastern 0.4 mile to be completed to ADA standards in 2011.

Getting there:

Take Hwy 49 west towards Downieville.

Access from:

- A** Turn right onto Cement Hill Rd., then turn left onto 115 Cement Hill Rd. Parking to your left.
- B** Continue onto Hwy 49 for approximately 2.4 miles. Across the street from the Willo restaurant, turn right onto Indian Flat Rd. Trailhead is at the southwest corner of the first intersection with Indian Flat Rd. Park along the road shoulder.
- C** Follow the directions of B), but make a right onto Indian Flat Rd and drive for 0.6 mi. Trailhead is to your right. Park along road shoulder.

Distance: 2.4 mi one way from Cement Hill Rd. to Indian Flat Rd. Woods Ravine Trail is 0.2 mi one way.

Elevation change: 150 feet.

Uses: Foot and bike only. No motorized vehicles.
Dogs on leash.
